Eastside Foreshore Jetty Condition Change

Port Augusta City Council (Council) advises community members and visitors that there has been a change in the condition of the eastside foreshore jetty (referred to as the 'T' jetty).

As a result of recent further structural decline to the underneath of the jetty, Council has erected temporary fencing as a precautionary and interim safety measure to ensure the jetty cannot be accessed via the water. Council asks community members and visitors to remain clear of the area around the temporary fencing.

Council will continue to update community members and visitors regarding the status of the jetty.

Council is currently engaging with stakeholders in preparing a longer term solution regarding the jetty and will provide the community with regular progress updates.
